We are now starting our 6th week of Lockdown!! I hope you and your families are keeping well. All of the School staff are well and we want you to know how much everyone misses you.

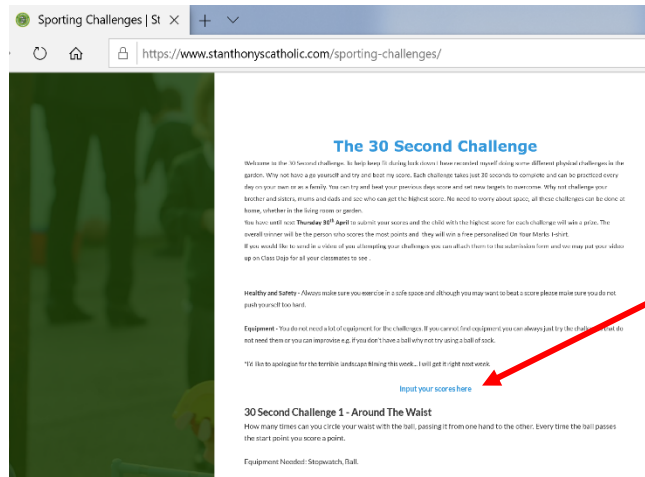
