Activity 1 - Reading

Activity 3 - Understanding the World

- **Activity 4 - Physical Development**
 - Make a spider out of paper plates.
 - You could use straws or pipe cleaners for legs.

Maths -Activities

- Write numbers on the floor. Can they jump on the number you shout out? You could change the game to jump on odd or even numbers or on a number more or less than .
- Play hop scotch .
- Write a number on paper and help your child collect that number of objects you could go up to 20 objects or even more than 20.
