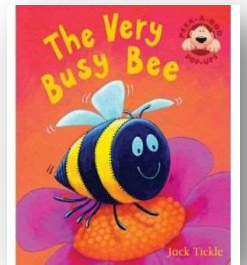
Here are some ideas to help support home learning this week.

Activity 1 - Reading

- Have a listen to the story 'The Very Busy Bee' by Jack Tickle which you can listen to via You Tube.
- It is a lovely rhyming book that introduces lots of different minibeasts.
- Use the website Play Phonics which is currently available free. A good game this week would be 'Space race' where children have to write in a word to match the picture.

Activity 2 - Writing

- Don't forget to write your name on your work.
- Practise letter formation.
- Write a shopping list to take to the supermarket.

Activity 3 - Understanding the World

- What can you find out about bees?
- Can you make a honey sandwich? What else could you make out of honey?

• Activity 4 - Physical Development

- Plant and grow some cress seed.
- Collect petals and leaves from outside and add them to a bucket or bowl of water to make a potion.



Maths -Activities

- Use stones and chalk to make addition sums when you are outside - if you don't have stones use twigs or leaves.
- Write numbers on the floor. Can they jump on the number you shout out? You could change the game to jump on odd or even numbers or on a number more or less than .
- Make sure you practise writing your numbers to 20 each week.
