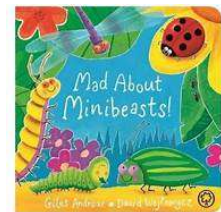
Here are some ideas to help support home learning this week.

### Activity 1 - Reading

- We will continue with the text *Mad about Minibeast* by Giles Andreae; there are versions of this story available to watch on YouTube.

### Activity 2 - Writing

- What can you find out about ladybirds?
