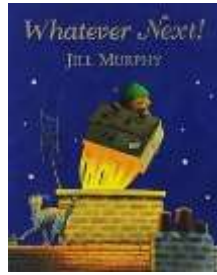


Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> November 2023



Dear Parents, Grandparents and Carers,

There have been lots of bonfires and fireworks to celebrate Bonfire Night and there will be even more to celebrate Diwali next weekend. If you can help with our celebrations next week, please let us know. In nursery we will act out building a bonfire, talk about fire safety and paint bonfire and firework pictures. We might even visit Forest School to observe sparklers and a small fire (at a safe distance), and to enjoy some hot chocolate!

Our story is “Whatever Next”; it is about a bear that goes to the moon in a cardboard box rocket! We think this will encourage lots of imaginative play as well as lots of counting from 1 to 5 as the rocket blasts off! We might use our “creation station” to make cardboard tube rockets. We will be talking about using scissors safely- not waving them around and looking where we are cutting!

Our rhyme for the week is a counting rhyme-if you don’t know the tune, Google “5 little men in a flying saucer/ songs you need to sing in the classroom/ twinkl”:

*5 little men in a flying saucer,  
Flew round the Earth one day.  
They looked left and right but they didn’t like the sight,  
So one man flew away.*



*4 little men in a flying saucer etc*

As well as our fire-works theme, we have our special number which is “6”- 5 fingers and one more! We are also learning about plastic pollution and its impact on sea creatures because the whole school is taking part in the CAFOD climate justice art project- look out for photos of our contribution.
