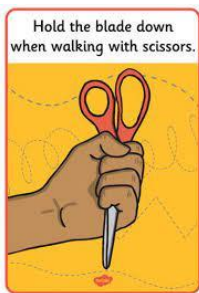


Dear Parents, Grandparents and Carers,

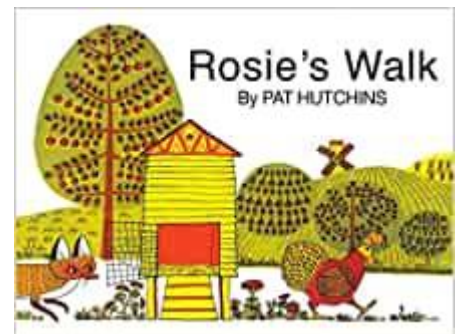
This week our focus is on God's Creation- we will be reading a simple version of the Bible story and singing a rhyme about it. It is sung to the tune of "Mary Had a Little Lamb":

*Do you know who made the world,  
made the world, made the world?  
Do you know who made the world?  
It was God who made the world.*

You can replace the word 'world' with other things that God created (cows, dogs, trees, etc).



We will be thinking about the differences between day and night and learning how to use scissors safely whilst making a paper-plate sun. We sit down when we use scissors and never wave them around. If we have to walk with scissors, we hold them upside down.



We will also be enjoying the story, "Rosie's Walk". We will have a go at making an obstacle course to represent the hen's farmyard walk; we will use different prepositions as we go across, around, behind, under and over. Why not go for a walk together- under (or over) the bridge, along the path, past the shops etc. There is new vocabulary that you might need to explain to your child: pond, beehive, windmill. We might try making egg sandwiches as well! Buttering bread is a great skill to practise and we can talk about different sandwich shapes.

The weather is getting more autumnal. Please make sure your child has a coat every day; we always go outside and this week we might visit the school field. We are hoping to have a tractor come to school as well this week!

If you are buying a new coat, please choose one that has a hood and isn't too tight so your child can put it on themselves. Show them how to check the sleeves of their coat and if they are inside out, pull the coat sleeves the right way out. If you are buying new shoes or boots, please make sure they are easy for your child to put on (no laces or zips please). Thank you.
