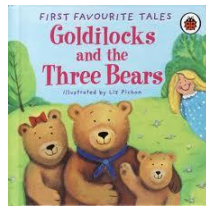


Monday 20th January 2025



Dear Parents, Grandparents and Carers,

This week we are focusing on the story of "Goldilocks and the three bears", acting out the story in the home-corner and retelling it with teddies and story props. We will be investigating the concepts of hot and cold and dry and wet as we play with oats and make porridge. We will also do lots more counting to 3, with lots of sorting and matching according to size e.g. a big bowl for Daddy bear, a medium bowl for Mummy bear and a small bowl for Baby bear. You might like to try this at home with different sized bowls, cups, spoons and teddies. Don't forget to count them all.

Our rhyme for this week will be

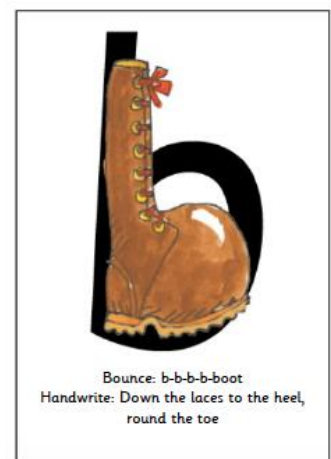
*When Goldilocks went to the house of the bears,
